Transition to Kagugu & New Focus Area 2018

Kabuhunde community saw children of school age not attending school. Apostle Mignonne took action, using her own funds to build an early childhood education school, starting with four classrooms.

The school, later named "Ishami Nursery Community School," became a beacon of transformation in the community.

Apostle Migonne's dreams of vulnerable children in need

- She saw a child fall into a drainage channel during heavy rain.
- She saw a mother throwing her newborn baby over the fence of Noble Family Church.

Foundation of the Feed my Sheep Center

- Built a kitchen originally serving 30 children daily.
- Partnered with the Kinyinya sector during enrollment & regular health check-ups.

Program Model



Phase 1 : Enrolment

- Partner with District and Sector leaders to identify children fighting malnutrition from communities of Gisozi, Kagugu, and Rwanda Women Network Program participants.
- Provide immediate health support (hygiene, nutrition, medical check up) and discipleship.

Phase 2 : Empowerment

- Provide daily balanced and nutritious meals to children in the program
- Parents receive daily meals and biannual food supplies, while children and parents are provided clothing as needed.
- Sponsorship for health insurance, school fees and essentials.
- Equip parents with healthy meals preparation, business training and start-up capital.

Phase 3 : Graduation

- Conduct regular follow-ups for sustainable growth.
- Facilitate access to employment and cooperative opportunities.

Center Daily Operations

Nutritious Meals

Daily nutritious meals are provided to over 100 children, including porridge, vegetables, proteins, and fruits, ensuring proper growth and energy for learning.



Care

Regular health check-ups are conducted in partnership with local health centers. Hygiene protocols, are strictly followed to ensure children's health and safety.

Support

Educational and emotional support is offered to both children and families. The program helps children start school and provides mothers with guidance, healing, and support, leading to positive life changes.

Empowerment

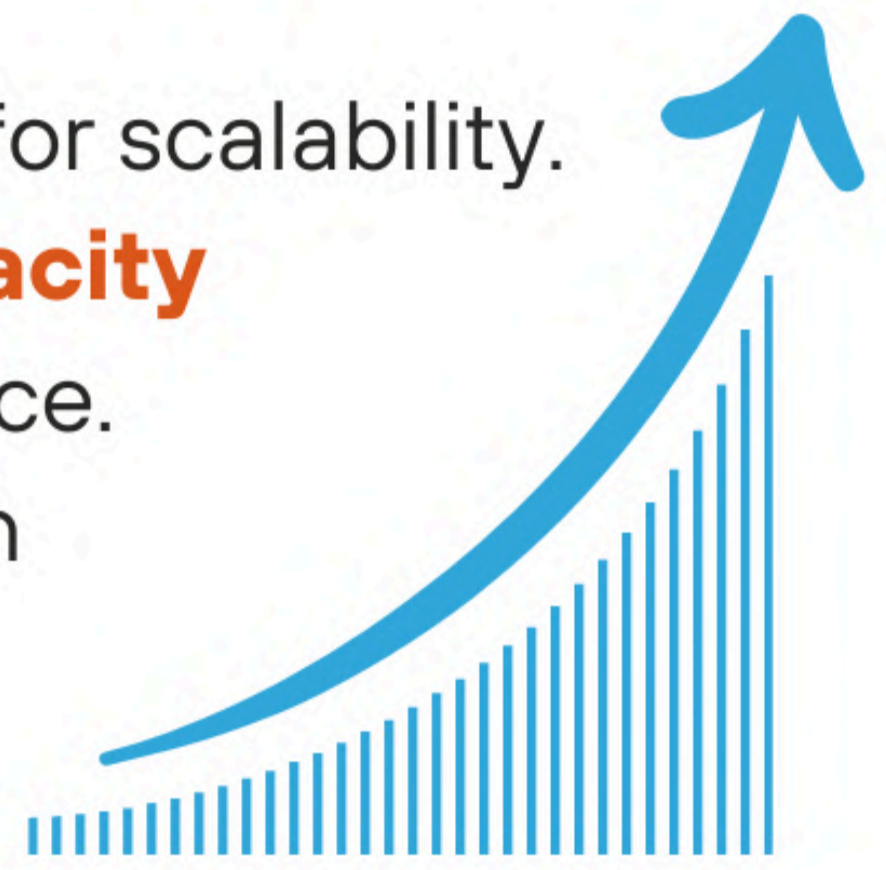
Parents receive trainings such as preparing balanced meals and business trainings like tailoring, making soya products, soaps, etc.; and start-up capital, empowering them to improve their families' livelihoods. Local partnerships and volunteer programs play a key role in sustaining this transformation.

Impact to Date

- **791** children graduated from **11 Cohorts** 6-month long with developmental milestones achieved. **Grew** from a **30** to **100** children per cohort.
- **685** supported and trained in business skills.
- **80%** of parents of children in the program received Jesus Christ as their King & Savior, totally changing their lives.
- Parents, mostly mothers, have recovered from depression, addictions, and prostitution.
- Improved livelihoods for **400+** families, reuniting **50+** couples.
- Grew from a **RWF 700K** to **5M+ budget per month**, mostly funded by Apostle Mignonne Kabera.
- Employs **8** full-time staff and **12** volunteers.
- Recognized by Gasabo District and the City of Kigali as the **Best Community Partner in fighting malnutrition for three consecutive years**.

Growth Plan 2025 & Beyond

- **Raise funds** through diversified partnerships to expand to **all 30 districts across Rwanda**, impacting 1,000+ children annually.
- Strengthen **operational systems** for scalability.
- Invest in **staff and volunteer capacity building** for long-term quality service.
- Deepen community impact through **innovative models of care and empowerment**.



Lessons Learned

- The success of the program is rooted in **the continuous engagement and leadership of local community leaders** throughout every stage.
- **The program has seen success**, with many children graduating and parents transforming their lives. About 5% of children temporarily drop out due to home life challenges. **These children are always welcomed back** into future cohorts.
- Need to invest in **robust impact measurement** to meet sector standards.
- **The demand** for the program remains high across communities, **highlighting the need for expansion** to reach more families and children in need.
- While we **face limited funding**, we **maximize resources**, and **we are actively seeking new support** to ensure the program's growth and sustainability.
